The **Scottish Wider Access Programme** is a way for adult learners to fulfil their academic potential and study for a degree or a HNC/D qualification at college or university.

**A SWAP programme could be for you if you...**

- Have been out of full-time education for 3 years or more (5 years if you have Highers or a HN qualification)
- Don't already have a university degree
- Are ready to focus on your education and want to progress to a degree or to a HNC/D

Previous qualifications are not normally required for entry.





## What can I study?

There are SWAP Programmes on a wide range of subject areas including arts and social sciences, languages, sciences, engineering, and nursing. They provide a route into thousands of different degree programmes at partner universities and colleges in Scotland.

## Where can I study on a SWAP programme?

SWAP programmes run at many local colleges across Scotland. All SWAP programmes are full-time and take one year, running annually from August to June.

## How much will it cost?

Funding will depend on your personal circumstances but for the vast majority of SWAP students course fees are fully funded. Most are also eligible for a college bursary.
