GCU will make selection decisions based mainly on personal statements and additional information requested from the College, in the form of an interim profile. Thereafter students will be invited to GCU for an interview/selection session. Please note advice that GCU and SWAP provide on writing your personal statement for nursing. Candidates should consider the branch of nursing they are applying for very carefully. Their choice of branch should be reflected in the skills articulated in their personal statement. Child nursing is highly competitive. For Child nursing and Mental Health nursing students can add a second UCAS choice for adult or learning disability. Personal statement remain focussed on first choice of branch. GCU will consider students for their main choice and contingency plan. Students applying for adult or learning disability as their main choice will not require a contingency option. For Learning Disability places, please advise your tutor you intend to apply. Places are subject to interview and successful Occupational Health and Criminal Records checks.
