


Scottish Wider Access Programme – key outcomes in 23/24

The Scottish Wider Access Programme (SWAP) is a national widening access programme, mainly funded by the Scottish Funding Council, with students enrolling on SWAP programmes throughout the country. SWAP aims to give opportunities to adult returners from wherever they are living in Scotland. SWAP is recognised nationally as an extremely important access route for adults with few formal qualifications to access higher education. Since 1998 more than 40,000 students have used this route to move onto, and succeed at HN and degree level.


KEY SWAP ACTIVITY IN 2023/24




*comparative data for FE completion rate at a national level not yet available for 23/24. For 22/23 the pass rate was 64%
